


The volume created is supported by the legs, whose design is based on the idea of two metallic tubes in an inverted "L" shape and presented in two finishes: taupe and matt satin bronze.

Its classic contemporary language allows it to be upholstered in any fabric, from silky velvets to structural contemporary fabrics.





Ales Ximo Roca


Functional and minimal, the soft and harmonic design of the Ales armchair invites you to sit down, providing you with the perfect space to relax and take a rest.

The collection of side tables Soffia was born by the inspiration in the ornamental variations of Islamic art, the geometric plasterwork, intertwined geometric shapes...

By extending the sides of a square, you can widen its surface area thereby defining the position of the structure's feet.

The Soffia collection is formed by three rod structures which are painted in the oven with special epoxy paints, of high resistance, finished in black. These structures are covered with different shapes: squared, rectangular, and circular with the possibility of two materials: marble (white carrara, black marquina, emperador) and lacquered (white, black and taupe). The combination of both elements generates four different possibilities of side tables.

The structure enables the positioning of a second cover of tempered glass, which can be used as a magazine rack, with finishes in white, black and taupe.

Throughout his career, he has obtained several awards in design such as the Contract World Awards, the Red Dot, ICFF Editors Awards, the HIP Award in Chicago, the FAD awards as well as several ASCER awards.

His work has been widely spread through the general press, as well as through specialized publications at national and international levels. Moreover, several books gathering his most outstanding creations have been edited. For many years he has been a teacher and has an active role in conferences, talks, and workshops.

University professor, graphic and industrial designer, Javier Pastor studied his Masters in Design and Design Management in the Domus Academy in Milan in 1996. Later he worked as designer and researcher in the Fujitsu Laboratory of Industrial Design, in Tokyo, and since the year 2000 he collaborates with the Universidad Politécnica de Valencia as professor in the Drawing Department.

He has developed projects in diverse sectors: furniture, lighting, product, graphic design and communication. As researcher of the IGD (Research and Management Design Group of the Universidad Politécnica de Valencia), he works in consultancy and training projects regarding design management and product portfolios, collaborating with different companies and organizations. He also collaborates internally with the design departments of companies managing product portfolios, elaborating communication strategies, and managing industrial and graphic design projects, as well as artistic management and aesthetics.

Lievore Altherr Molina

The Lievore Altherr Molina studio, formed by Alberto Lievore, Jeannette Altherr and Manel Molina, is born from the union of its three members in 1991. This studio is dedicated to product and interior design, packaging, consultancy, and art management. It is well-known for its furniture designs, it's all about creating designs where simplicity and functionality combine with aesthetically pure and appealing shapes.

Its work, characterized by a multidisciplinary method which comprises the design of furniture, interiors, products and packaging, has been exhibited and recognised at an international level. In 1999 the studio was awarded with the prestigious National Design Award in Spain, and since then they have been working hard and have been worthy of numerous national and international awards.

Active in the academic field, the studio also organizes seminars, workshops and collaborates with many Spanish universities.

His professional career as industrial designer started in 1981, collaborating with different companies in the Spanish Mediterranean coast area up until 1989, when he decided to create the Ximo Roca Design Studio. The trajectory of Ximo over the world encompasses also many years in the education sector. He has been a professor in the Design School of the Universidad Católica CEU San Pablo. Ximo Roca is undoubtedly an original and versatile designer. During his more than 30 years of work he has created many products which are nowadays widely extended in the market.
