

Loop by Norm Architects: in the loop of timeless design

That's exactly how *Loop* chair was devised by Danish studio Norm Architects. For starters, it's made of rattan, a natural material, as delicate to the sight as resistant to the test of time. It can last more than a lifetime. And then there's its particular design: its curvilinear shape drawing a sort of charming smile, its flexible backrest, neat lines (the amount of rattan used in its making has been reduced to the max, therefore reducing its carbon footprint) and compact size bring back to memory those chairs of turn-of-the-century cafés in Viena and Paris.

In the words of their own designers: "Loop is our take on the classic multipurpose chair: a dining chair, a café chair, a kitchen chair, a balcony chair, that extra chair in a nice corner or in the hallway. The reason is its construction, both classic and modern, an approach that makes it versatile and elegant, fit to any place and occasion. A chair that never grows old."

An essential design just as far from fads.

Together with *Loop* and *Cask* outdoor, we will introduce the new versions of collections such as *Talo* by Altherr Désile Park or *Lapala* by Lievore Altherr Molina and, some other surprise.
