High-performance mattresses with breathable, ergonomic and sustainable technologies complete the experience, offering the ultimate in restorative sleep.

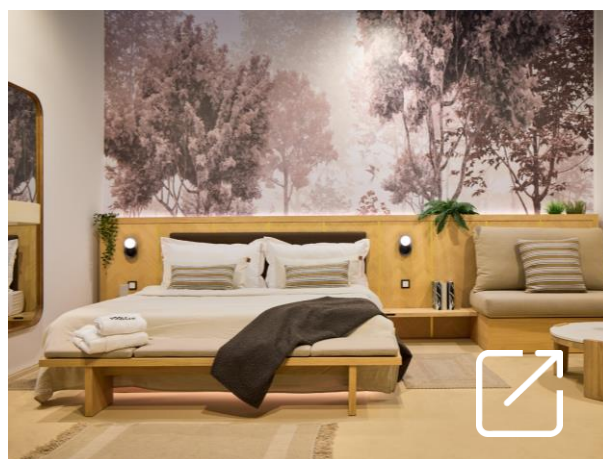

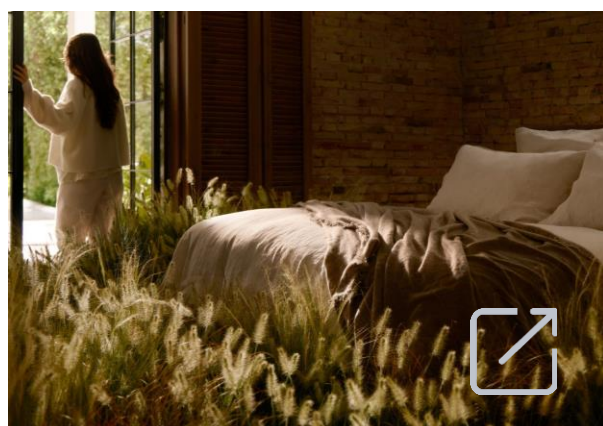

Outdoor Spaces

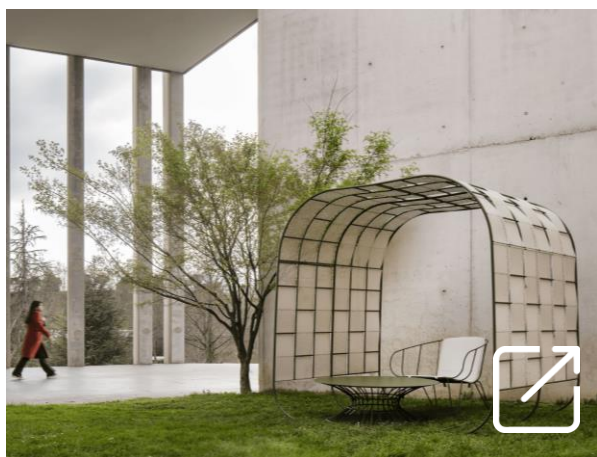

With a strong Mediterranean influence, these spaces celebrate light, air, and nature—inviting relaxation, social connection, and year-round enjoyment.

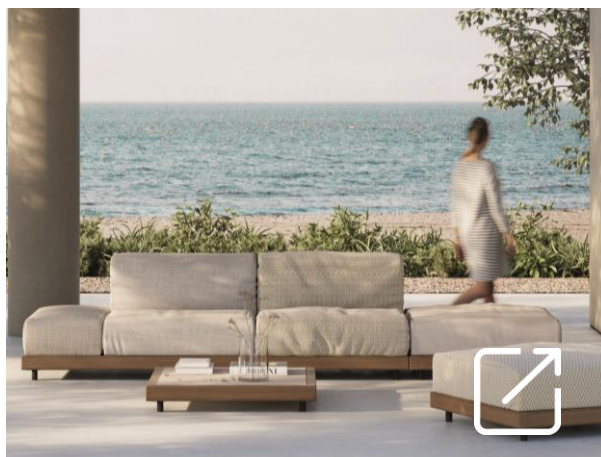

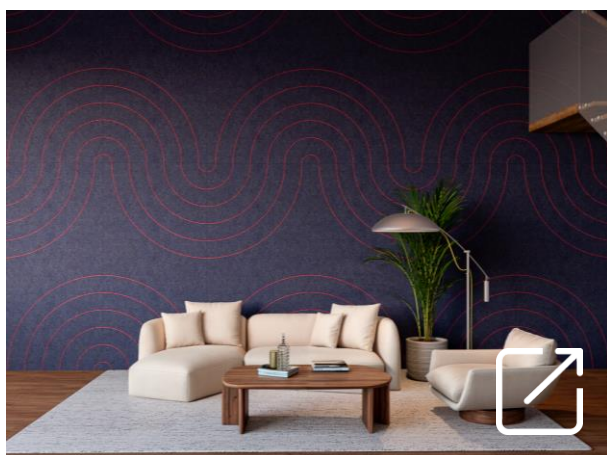

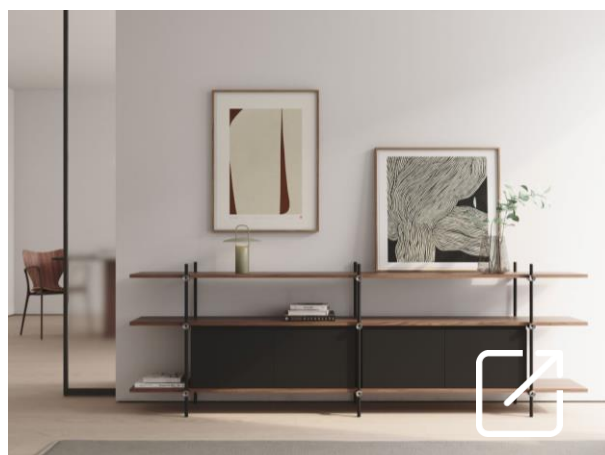
