From April 21 to 26, 2026, and for the third year in a row, SKLD Studio will take part in Salone del Mobile in Milan, reinforcing the group's commitment to design and innovation. Founded in 2024 as part of Voolcan Grupo, SKLD Studio follows the group's presence at the fair since 2016 with its other outdoor brand, Skyline Design.

SKLD Studio's participation in Salone del Mobile since its inception underscores its ambition to affirm a distinctive vision of authorial outdoor furniture, through collaborations with leading designers such as Alberto Lievore, La Mamba and Eli Gutiérrez, among others. A choice that places talent and design at the core, with the aim of building a solid and enduring language within the high-end outdoor design segment.

The brand's creation responds to the growing demand for pieces that combine creativity, high-quality materials and meticulous production. With a forward-looking approach, SKLD Studio explores new forms of expression in outdoor furniture that go beyond functionality, becoming authentic expressions of style and sophistication. These are outdoor furnishings and accessories conceived not only with an aesthetic purpose, but also to generate emotions, bringing character and exclusivity to every project.

The new proposals stand out for their careful selection of chromatic finishes, featuring tones such as forest green, oxide red and smoky purplish grey—a sophisticated palette that adds depth and character to each piece. The designs favor rounded, soft and enveloping volumes, conveying a sense of balance and visual harmony.

With a clear timeless vocation, the collections combine elegance and functionality, developed through subtle lines and refined proportions. Each piece reflects a meticulous design process, where aesthetics and detail engage in dialogue to create objects conceived to coexist naturally and serenely with their surroundings.

SKLD Studio collaborates with designers with a strong design culture to build, collection after collection, a recognizable positioning within the premium outdoor design segment. At the most important event for the international design industry, SKLD Studio presents three new collections, along with several new pieces from the existing Koro collection designed by **Eli Gutiérrez**, as well as the Serra collection by **Kar Durán** and **Miguel López**. Serra draws on the essence of classic rattan chairs and proposes a bold design that combines traditional seat weaving with slender metal legs, breaking away from conventional aesthetics.

More specifically:

- a complete outdoor furniture collection designed by internationally renowned Italian designer **Valerio Sommella**, who has collaborated with leading companies across different sectors such as Alessi, Nemo and RH;
- a complete collection by **Kar Durán** and **Miguel López**, designers of the Serra collection;
- three new pieces (sun lounger, chair and dining armchair) expanding the Koro collection presented last year at Salone, designed by Spanish designer **Eli Gutiérrez**;
- a modular collection focused on furniture accessories, designed by Scottish designer **Adam Johnston**, based between Barcelona and the United Kingdom, who presented the Umbra collection last year.

In addition, SKLD Studio will be part of Fuorisalone within the *Appartamento Spagnolo*, a project by *Elle Decor Italia* in collaboration with *Interiors From Spain (ICEX)*, featuring a selection of pieces curated by StudioPepe: *Olma*, designed by **La Mamba Studio**, and the *Serra* daybed by **Kar Durán & Miguel López** in the White Wash version.
